#### PARADE TIME SCHEDULE

9:30 am

Participants arrive at Berlin Elementary School (via Southeast Hollow Road)

<u>Please sign in upon arrival</u>. You or your group representative must sign in at the registration desk located on the front steps of the school, whether or not you have pre-registered.

10:00 am

Judging begins. All participants should be together with their entry group at their assigned

area and in judging format. \* (Prizes are awarded prior to start of parade).

11:00 am

Parade steps off promptly!

\*If floats or any entrants are not present at this time, they <u>may not</u> be judged. The parade committee requires this time to line up the various contingents so that the parade can begin on time.


#### PARADE ROUTE

- From the Berlin Elementary School north on School Street to Park Avenue;
- Left onto Park Avenue to Community Avenue;
- Right onto Community Avenue, past the firehouse, to Elm Street;
- Left onto Elm Street, at Hewitt's Market, to Route 22;
- Right onto Route 22, at former Bank of America, now Stewarts, to North Main Street;
- Left onto North Main Street and proceed to the end of South Main Street;
- Motorized units (unless instructed otherwise) turn RIGHT onto Route 22 and return to Berlin
   Elementary School via (left onto) Southeast Hollow Road. Walkers turn LEFT onto Route 22, then right
   onto Park Avenue, ending at firehouse parking lot.



Immediately following the parade, all participants are invited to the firehouse where cold beverages will be available, compliments of the Berlin Vol Fire Company. Hill Hollow Band will be performing in the parking lot for your entertainment pleasure. Stop by!
